R-Value 38:

Material:

It's usually made from fiberglass or mineral wool, both known for strong insulation and some soundproofing.

Thickness:

R-38 insulation is typically about 14 inches thick and it's a solid layer of protection for your home.

Installed in Key Areas: Mostly used in attics and ceilings, but sometimes in walls if higher insulation is needed.

Optional Vapor Barrier: Some R-38 insulation has a kraft paper facing. This helps block moisture and prevent mold.

Right Fit Matters: It comes in rolls or batts, and it's important that it's installed snugly with no gaps or compression.
